Side defender **Annie Wickett** is the first summer transfer to Champions League next season!



After graduating from the University of Connecticut, 24-year-old Annie gained experience in the Women's Premier Soccer League, playing for teams like the Boston Breakers, with whom she won the title of national champion, or Washington Spirit, with which she became champion of the WPSL Colonial Conference.

Annie Wickett, who signed a season with "U" Olimpia Cluj, arrived in Cluj-Napoca and joined the team, already doing some training with the team.
